Lafiya's model appears to be working well at moderate scale and there is strong interest from two major payer-at-scale foundations, alongside securing co-financing MoUs from Government. They have also secured their supply chain for the foreseeable future. Major caveats are the lack of an implementation RCT and RCTs showing mixed results from contraceptive distribution.

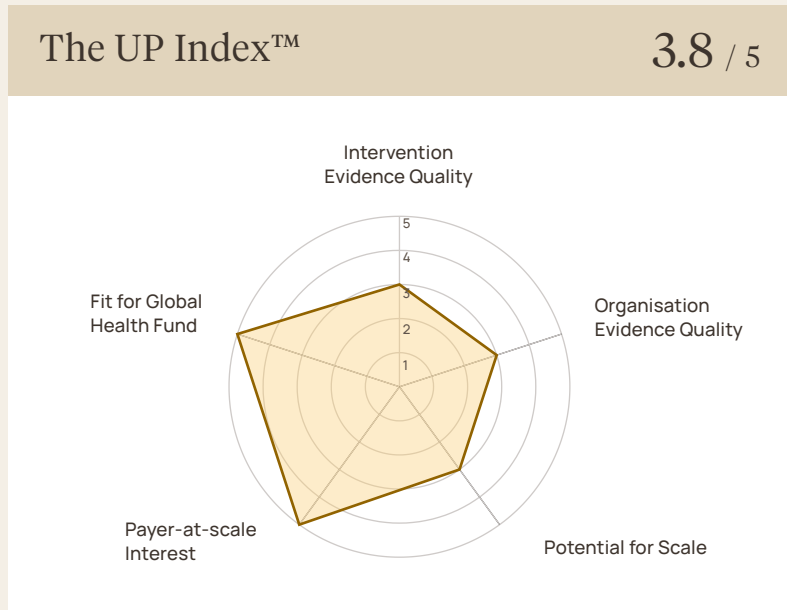
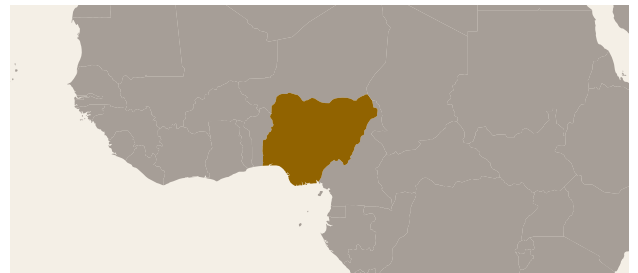
